

Cobalt Action Team

At the June 10th, 2013 council meeting, Creswell City Council voted to move forward with capital improvements to the Cobalt Building. This \$35,000 investment will be put towards preparing the building for utilization as a community recreation/ education center and flexible multi-use event space. Once work inside the building is complete, the next step will be to bring programming to the facility and gather feedback on how it is being used.

In order to bring recreation programs and community events to the Cobalt Building a Cobalt Action Team has been formed to market the building, plan events, attract additional partners and continue engaging the Creswell community over the course of the next year. The team will work directly with the City's RARE participant who will be responsible to report back to Creswell's City Administrator.

The charge given to the Cobalt Action Team breaks down as follows:

- Market the use of the Cobalt Building
- Plan and support events held at the Cobalt Building
- Work to establish new partnerships and strengthen existing partnerships
- Gather data on the use of the building
- Gather community feedback on the use of the building
- Periodically update Creswell City Council on progress
