Application for Parks Advisory Board Vacancy

Creswell Ordinance 431 - The Ordinance Creating an Advisory Park Board, Prescribing its Powers and Duties, outlines how vacancies created on the Park Board shall be filled as follows:

Section 1 Park Board

There is hereby created a Board for the purpose of advising and assisting the Council of the City of Creswell in developing, planning for and maintaining the various parks, open space, and recreation facilities and programs in which the City of Creswell has an interest.

Section 2 Appointments; Terms of Office:

Said Board shall be appointed by the Mayor with the Consent of the City Council and shall consist of nine (9) members, one of whom shall be a City Councilor. The remaining members shall be from, in, and around the City of Creswell. The term of members shall be three (3) years with one-third being appointed for each calendar year. The Mayor shall designate the terms of those appointed initially.

Section 3 Duties

The Board shall advise and assist the Council in developing, planning for, and maintaining all parks, open space, and recreational facilities and programs in which the City of Creswell has an interest.

Section 4 Meetings

The Board shall meet at such times and places as are required for carrying out its duties. All such meetings shall be called and held in accordance with Oregon's Public Meetings Law.

Section 5 Expenditures

The Board shall not have power to spend funds of the City except for expenditures authorized by the City Council.

Section 6 Quorum

A majority of the members shall constitute a quorum.

Section 7 Officers

The Board shall elect from its members a chairperson to serve during each calendar year. Any vacancy occurring on the Board shall be filled by the Mayor appointing a new member for the unexpired term.

Section 8 Records, Information and Actions

The Board shall keep records of the meetings and shall make such records available to the City Council when required. The Board shall cause to be delivered to the Council all resolutions, recommendations, and information, which will be helpful to the City in developing, planning for, and maintaining all parks, open space, and recreation facilities and programs, in which the City of Creswell has an interest.

Section 9 Powers

The Board shall comply with State and Federal requirements for assistance in obtaining funds and property for park development.
