**1. Public Hearing**

Mayor Hooker opened the Public Hearing on Ordinance 464 – An Ordinance Regulating and Providing for the Collection and Disposal of Solid Waste within the City of Creswell; Granting an Exclusive Franchise for the Collection and Disposal of Solid Waste and Defining the Terms Thereof: Prohibiting Unlawful, Accumulation, Transportation, or Disposal of Solid Waste; Providing Penalties; Repealing Ordinance 463; and Declaring an Emergency. Mr. Hooker explained this hearing was in regards to awarding an exclusive franchise to Waste Connections who have recently purchased P & J Disposal Service that currently serves the City of Creswell.

Mr. Hooker asked for public comment:

Frank Beltran who resides at 82422 Bear Creek Road in Creswell addressed the Council asking if Waste Connections will service P & J Disposal customers who reside outside of the city limits of Creswell.

Jason Craft of Waste Connections addressed the question by saying they would be taking over all of P & J Disposal's current accounts unless the customer chooses to cancel their service regardless as to it being in the City or the County.

There being no further public testimony, Mayor Hooker closed the Public Hearing. A small discussion ensued regarding the expiration date of the franchise being June 30, 2017, a section being added to address City Wide Clean-up Day and the rates staying the same as passed by Resolution 2009-34.

Bob Hooker moved and read twice by title Bill McCoy seconded that Council adopt Ordinance 464 – An Ordinance Regulating and Providing for the Collection and Disposal of Solid Waste within the City of Creswell; Granting an Exclusive Franchise for the Collection and Disposal of Solid Waste and Defining the Terms Thereof; Prohibiting Unlawful Accumulation, Transportation, or Disposal of Solid Waste;

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Providing Penalties; Repealing Ordinance 463; and Declaring an Emergency. Voted on and carried unanimously.
