1. Elect Council President

Mayor Tim Demanett opened the nominations for Council President.

The results in the Council's votes are as follows: In favor of Bob Hooker are: Tim Demanett, Bob Millam, Bill McCoy, and Bob Hooker, with Mike Ufford and David Case abstained. In favor of David Case: There being no votes in favor, those opposing are Tim Demanett, Bob Millam, Bill McCoy, and Bob Hooker with Mike Ufford and David Case abstaining. The new Council President is Bob Hooker.

2. Appoint/Re-Appoint Budget Committee Members

Mayor Tim Demanett read the budget committee membership list of Creswell citizens: Michelle Thielke, Betty Beckner, Martin Heymann, Pete Nelson, Keith Morgan, and Michael Dubick. Mr. Demanett read the Council staff: Bill McCoy, Bob Millam, Mike Ufford, Bob Hooker, David Case, and Tim Demanett. Finance Director Layli Nichols said from the citizen membership list Michelle Thielke has indicated she is moving out of town, Betty Beckner no longer wants to participate, and Pete Nelson has moved out of town therefore, the appointment would be for Keith Morgan. Tim Demanett nominated Keith Morgan to be appointed to the Budget Committee. Bill McCoy moved Bob Millam seconded to appoint Keith Morgan to the budget committee. Voted on and carried unanimously. Ms. Nichols said there are three vacancies that need to be filled on the budget committee and encouraged councilors to recruit community members.

There being no further business to come before the council, Mayor Demanett adjourned the meeting.
